The practical team will work with the community on projects that solve key healthcare issues; anything from building pit latrines to building walls around wells. The teachers will carry out a needs assessment and offer relevant training to local teachers.

We also need 2 teachers (primary and/or secondary) and 4 people willing to build, repair and work on practical projects.
