**TRIP PURPOSE** To provide ongoing Community Healthcare training, to teach on priority topics, link the training to practical projects and build relationship with our partners and community influencers.  
To provide Micro-Enterprise Development training for administrators overseeing local initiatives.  
The practical team will work with the community on projects that solve key healthcare issues; anything from building pit latrines to building walls around wells.

**TRIP TEAM** We need 8 Community Healthcare enthusiasts who love communicating and have a passion to teach, empower and inspire others. Participants will need to be flexible and adaptable.  
We need 2 people who love communicating and have a passion to train micro-enterprise administrators so they are equipped to successfully train, support others and develop successful initiatives.  
We need 3 people willing to build, repair and work on practical projects.

Flights	International and in-country flights are booked for UK participants. A non-refundable flight deposit of £100 must be submitted as soon as the Trip Application has been approved. The balance of flight money should be paid no later than 2 months prior to the departure date. Failure to complete payment on time may result in exclusion from the trip. Participants from other countries may be required to book their own international flights but in-country flight bookings will be made by Links. A flight deposit may also be required once the Trip Application has been approved.
Food	Cash is required for meals. A daily amount is recommended under Trip Costs.
Accomm.	Links will make all bookings and participants pay in cash on the trip.
