Flights	International and in-country flights are booked for UK participants. A non-refundable flight deposit of £100 must be submitted as soon as the Trip Application has been approved. The balance of flight money should be paid no later than 2 months prior to the departure date. Failure to complete payment on time may result in exclusion from the trip. Participants from other countries may be required to book their own international flights but in-country flight bookings will be made by Links. A flight deposit may also be required once the Trip Application has been approved.
Food	Cash is required for meals. A daily amount is recommended under Trip Costs.
Accomm.	Links will make all bookings and participants pay in cash on the trip.
